As a 2024 Ignite Team Leader, you will lead incoming students in small groups, educating them about campus resources and leadership opportunities, and guiding them through their transition to the University of Tennessee. Team Leaders foster meaningful connections and relationships with new students while helping them learn what it means to be a Volunteer. As a Team Leader, you will also develop your leadership skills as you grow in your leadership journey.

TEAM LEADER ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS

- → Must have and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 & be in good standing with the university
- → Must be enrolled full time (12 credit hours) at UT for Spring and Fall 2024 semesters
- → Must be enrolled in and successfully pass the 2024 Ignite Team Leader class
- → Must be open to learning and challenging oneself to grow in leadership capacities
- → Must be open to receiving and responding to constructive feedback
- → Must be willing to support and adhere to the mission of JCLS, UT Student Life, and UTK

TEAM LEADER RESPONSIBILITIES AND SKILLS

Community and Empowerment

- → Assist with new students' transition into the University of Tennessee
- → Develop peers' and new students' interpersonal and leadership skills
- → Challenge peers' and new students to examine and establish their leadership style, values, and goals
- → Foster an inclusive environment for the UTK community
- → Serve as a positive example for all undergraduate students at the University of Tennessee

Facilitation

- → Lead a small group of students through teambuilding initiatives, diversity education, values clarification, and identity activities
- $\rightarrow\,$ Educate new students about University of Tennessee traditions and campus leadership opportunities

Ethics

- → Display elements of respect for humanity by respecting the person and respecting the space
- → Promote unity and shared learning among all people and experiences
- → Fill all unknown gaps with trust by acting in good faith

- → Leadership: Leverage the strengths of others to achieve common goals, and use interpersonal skills to coach and develop others
- → Teamwork/Collaboration: Build collaborative relationships with UTK community, Knoxville community partners, and all other Ignite stakeholders; ability to work within a team structure, and can negotiate and manage conflict

- → Use expertise and experience to teach, coach, and challenge individuals to reach their potential.
- → Offer critiques and advice in a timely and respectful manner to improve a student's decisions, effectiveness, or interactions with others.
- → Understand ways to manage group development during a meeting, activity, or conversation.
- → Effectively lead discussions, ask prompt questions, and keep the group on track.
- → Enhance cross cultural communication skills.
- → Understand how to develop productive relationships with other Ignite Team Leaders, Student Directors, and JCLS staff.
- → Believe in cultivating connections with others that contribute positively to their personal growth and the growth of the Ignite program.

- → Ignite Team Leader Course in the Spring 2024 semester
- → Participate in MLK Jr. Days of Service in Spring 2024
- → Ignite Staff Retreat February 9-11, 2024
- → 1-hr meeting with the Ignite Student Directors of staff development in the Spring
- → The full program session for which you are hired
