- Must be enrolled full time (12 credit hours) at UT for Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 semesters
- Must be able to enroll and pass the JCLS LEAD 349 Course (if not previously taken the JCLS ELPS 350 Course) in Fall 2025 (T 4:05 5:20 pm)
- Must be open to learning and challenging oneself to grow in leadership capacities
- Must be open to receiving and responding to constructive feedback
- Must be willing to support and adhere to the mission of JCLS, UT Student Life, and UTK
- Must be willing to demonstrate a commitment to all cohort members and their success
